## BACKGROUND

Governments and organizations around the world are facing an ever-increasing host of threats including natural disasters- due to continuously increasing weather abnormalities, cross-border health risks, un-intentional accidents, terrorism and cyber threats. The world is facing unparalleled threats from human-made disasters that can be attributed to the failure of industrial and energy installations as well as terrorism. Added to this is the unparalleled threat of emerging and re-emerging diseases, with scientists predicting events of influenza pandemics.

To protect the population and safeguard organizations from the impact of these hazardous incidents, effective planning and preparation, preparedness, response and recovery strategies are required along with an ever-growing requirement to enhance collaboration and capacity building initiatives within organizations and between multiple stakeholders- which is very commonly known as 'Disaster Management'.

## OBJECTIVES

The objective of the workshop is to primarily focus on and learn about current health risks, disaster management, need of disaster prevention, mitigation and preparedness in today's context and recover from disasters in order to reduce human health impacts. The workshop will help participants to understand the nature of hazards and risks, learn risk management strategies to prepare for disruptive events, and identify the best prevention methods in disaster management and public health. It will provide a forum for the exchange of information between leading academics and partners in disaster management.
